Atmospheric Exhaust Filter

Description: The IMAC Atmospheric Exhaust Filter is

designed to reduce third party customer complaints at stations with natural gas bleed lines. The Atmospheric Exhaust filter (scrubber) removes mercaptan odor / odorant from natural gas bleed and

natural gas vents.

Installation: Remove inlet and outlet covers

Pipe into place with vent side facing away from rainfall.

Applications: Instrumentation vents or bleed systems

that vent odorized natural gas; including intermittent or constant bleed lines. Examples include instrumentation panels, relief valves,

control valves, regulators,

pneumatic controllers, and odorant tanks

Specifications: Available in a variety of sizes;

Common sizes include 15G, 35G

and 55G

Inlet Options: ¼" thru 2"
Outlet: Open Vent

Working Pressure: Atmospheric

Material: Plastic Polymer Body

Media: Activated Charcoal
